- Admission schedule of the college shall be notified in due course of time on the above-mentioned website.

Note: No printed application form will be issued from the college. Applications will be considered only upon payment of the requisite **Application Fee of Rs. 100 (Candidates can apply in 3 B.A. Hons. and B.A. General course within this fee)**. Candidates can make the payment of application fee using Debit card and Credit card and through Net Banking system.

One candidate can apply in more than one subject.

- ✚ Candidate must take a print-out of the application form and payment challan/receipt generated after successful online submission of the form and produce the same **only at the time of physical verification of documents after the admission procedure.**
- ✚ All online admission is provisional and is subject to physical verification of relevant documents during the commencement of classes. The college reserves its right to cancel a candidate's admission if the documents are not found in conformity with the declaration made in the form submitted online.
- **Admission is conducted strictly on the basis of merit.**
- Date of publication of provisional merit list will be notified later on this website.

- After publication of provisional merit list online admission will be conducted and candidates are NOT required to report to the college for the process.

Note: College will not take any kind of responsibility if candidate's previous 10+2 board is not approved by the Vidyasagar University.

Eligibility criteria for admission:

In case of Board/Council other than W.B.C.H.S.E., a candidate shall have to pass in five [four, where applicable] recognized subjects of full marks not being less than 100 out of which one will be English. For them the merit point will be calculated converting their % of marks into 500.

Marks obtained in top five subjects shall be considered to ascertain the aggregate marks of a candidate passing the examination under grade system. Also for candidates passing H.S. (10+2) Examination from the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education under old system, marks obtained in top five subjects will be considered to determine the aggregate marks.

Marks obtained in Environmental Studies as a compulsory subject in the H.S. (10+2) Examination conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent will not be taken into account for calculation of the aggregate marks in top five subjects for the purpose of admission.

Candidates will not be considered for admission after a lapse of more than 3 (three) years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination or discontinuation of recognised regular courses of study after passing the previous qualifying examination.

Note: Candidates who have already come under examination system will not be eligible to take admission in this college again.

Explanation:

Applicants, who have passed the H.S. (10+2) Examination in the year 2017/2018/2019 are eligible to apply for Graduate Course in this college.

A candidate shall be allowed to take up the Honours subject(s) under heading '(X)' if she/he has passed the subject(s) under heading '(Y)' at the previous qualifying examination.

Merit Point Calculation:

Merit Point= X+Y

X = 10 percent of marks in aggregate in the 10+2 level exam taking 5 best marks among all the subjects excluding the marks of Environmental Studies.

Y= percentage of marks in applied subject as Honours. If that subject is not studied, the percentage of marks of one subject as indicated in the table below will be considered.

Honours Subject	Percentage of marks in applied subject as Honours, if that subject is not studied, consider the marks of one subject as indicated below:

Note that if more than one candidate score same merit point, preference will be given to higher Y; in this way, if more than one candidate have same score in Y, preference will be given to higher X.

Admission to all Honours/General courses will be strictly on the basis of eligibility criteria and merit.

- ✓ Applicants must produce the following documents in original and attach Xeroxed self-attested copies of these documents with the printout of the Application Form at the time of Physically Verification.
- ✚ Print Copy of the Application Form with necessary signature.
- ✚ Admit Card of Madhyamik or Equivalent Examination (Document showing the date of birth of the applicant).
- ✚ Marksheet of the Madhyamik or equivalent examination.
- ✚ Registration Certificate of the H.S. or equivalent examination.
- ✚ Admit card of the H.S. or equivalent examination.
- ✚ Mark sheet of the H.S. or equivalent examination.
- ✚ Category (Caste) Certificate. (if applicable)
- ✚ PH Certificate. (if applicable)
- ✚ School Leaving Certificate.
- ✚ Transfer certificate and University permission/Migration certificate in case the applicant already admitted in another college.
- ✚ A letter from the guardian mentioning the name and address of a local guardian in case of an outstation applicant.
- ✚ One copy stamp size colour photograph to be affixed in printout of the online form.

General Information for the Applicants:

[A] Eligibility Criteria for Application

For Honours Degree:

45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in the subject applied for or related subjects (TABLE-A)* at the previous qualifying examination.

For General Degree Courses:

Applicant must qualify the H.S. or equivalent examination.

No candidate shall be considered for admission after a lapse of more than 3 (three) years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination or discontinuation of recognized regular courses of study after passing the previous qualifying examination.

Explanation: The year of admission shall not be taken into account while calculating 3 years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

The candidates qualifying the vocational courses can apply for general degree courses only.

[B]Courses Offered:

The college offers 3 year Honours and General Degree courses a list of which along with the subject combinations is given above. Following points are to be noted:

For each Honours course two general subjects must have to be taken as subject combination.

For each General course three subjects must have to be taken as subject combination.

Documents Required During the time of physical verification after the admission procedure:

All valid applicants appearing in the Merit lists for the Honours/General courses must bring the following documents at the time of verification:

1. FILLED IN APPLICATION FORM [PRINTOUT OF THE FORM SUBMITTED ONLINE].
2. RECEIPT OF THE APPLICATION FEE (ORIGINAL CHALLAN-RECEIPT).
3. ALL DOCUMENTS (IN ORIGINAL AND SELF-ATTESTED TESTIMONIALS) LIKE H.S. MARKSHEETS ADMIT CARD FOR MADHYAMIK OR EQUIVALENT EXAMINATION, CASTE CERTIFICATE AND PH CERTIFICATE (IF APPLICABLE), ETC.
4. TWO RECENT STAMP-SIZE COLOR PHOTOGRAPHS.

All applicants for the Honours/General courses appearing in the Merit List may take their admission to the respective courses directly on the date mentioned on college website. During admission, the above documents are required to be produced at College Office.

Keep In Mind:

As per the recent verdict of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, ragging and sexual harassment in any form are criminal offences. Students involved in either of these unlawful events will be liable to disciplinary action taken by the competent authorities. Also, students have to abide by the discipline in the College and the rules framed by the Vidyasagar University. Candidates with short fall of attendance in their classes will be taken disciplinary action as per V.U. guidelines.

Candidate should note that

No application form(s) without bank challan(s) will be accepted.

The college reserves the right to admission. Submission of the application form along with requisite fees does not guarantee admission of the applicant.

The applicants must note that all admissions are provisional and subject to V.U approval. Any false information furnished in the application form is a punishable offence and renders the cancellation of the candidature though she/he gets admitted.

After getting admission if a candidate wishes to discontinue his/her studies or wants to strike out his/her name from this college, no money will be refunded. Ragging in all forms is liable to appropriate disciplinary action.

Eligibility to appear in V.U. Examinations is subject to attendance in college as per V.U. norms as follows

A candidate attending less than 75% but not below 60% of attendance in one or more subjects/groups of subjects shall be declared as NON-COLLEGIATE and may be allowed to appear at the concerned examination on payment of requisite Non-Collegiate fees.

A candidate attending less than 60% lectures delivered and practical classes held in one or more subject(s)/group(s) of subjects shall be declared as DISCOLLEGIATE and shall be debarred from appearing at the V.U. Examination.

Attendance in a subject/group of subjects shall be counted from the date of commencement of classes or admission to the course whichever is later.

N.B: If any kind of error is found in the application form or the candidate is unable to produce the relevant documents (like Caste Certificate, Mark sheet etc.) during the time of Physical Verification, the application of the candidate will be cancelled.
