# One candidate can apply in more than one subject

- ✓ Candidate must take a print-out of the application form generated after successful online submission of the form and produce the same only at the time of physical verification of documents after the admission procedure.
- ✓ All online admission is provisional and is subject to physical verification of relevant documents during the commencement of classes. The college reserves

its right to cancel a candidate's admission if the documents are not found in conformity with the declaration made in the form submitted online.



# Admission will be conducted strictly on the basis of merit

- ◆ Date of publication of provisional merit list will be notified on the college website.
- ◆ After publication of provisional merit list online admission will be conducted and candidates are NOT required to report to the college for the process.

# **Eligibility criteria for admission:**

- ❖ In case of Board/Council other than W.B.C.H.S.E., a candidate shall have to pass in five [four, where applicable] recognized subjects of full marks not being less than 100 out of which one will be English. For them the merit point will be calculated converting their % of marks into 500.
- ❖ Marks obtained in top five subjects shall be considered to ascertain the aggregate marks of a candidate passing the examination under grade system. Also for candidates passing H.S. (10+2) Examination from the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education under old system, marks obtained in top five subjects will be considered to determine the aggregate marks.
- ❖ Marks obtained in Environmental Studies as a compulsory subject in the H.S. (10+2) Examination conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent will not be taken into account for calculation of the aggregate marks in top five subjects for the purpose of admission.
- ❖ Candidates will not be considered for admission after a lapse of more than 3 (three) years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination or discontinuation of recognized regular courses of study after passing the previous qualifying examination.

Note: Candidates who have already come under examination system will not be eligible to take admission in this college again.



# **Explanation:**

- **❖** Applicants, who have passed the H.S. (10+2) Examination in the year 2021/2022/2023 are eligible to apply for Graduate Course in this college.
- A candidate shall be allowed to take up **B.A.** (**Hons.** / **Hons.** with **Research**) with **Major** under heading '(X)' if she/he has passed the subject (s) under heading '(Y)' in respective rows in the previous qualifying examination.

## **Process of Merit Point Calculation:**

#### **Merit Point=X+Y**

X = 10 percent of marks in aggregate in the 10+2 level exam taking 5 best marks among all the subjects excluding the marks of Environmental Studies.

Y= Percentage of marks in the subject applied for B.A. (Hons. / Hons. with Research) with Major. If that subject is not studied, the percentage of marks of one subject as indicated in the table below will be considered.

# GENERAL INFORMATION FOR THE APPLICANTS

# [A] Eligibility Criteria for Application

For 4-year B.A. (Hons. / Hons. with Research) with Major course:

45% marks in aggregate or 50% marks in the subject applied for or related subjects (TABLE-

A)\* at the previous qualifying examination.

For 3-year B.A. (Bachelor's Degree) with Multidisciplinary Programme:

Applicant must qualify the H.S. or equivalent examination.

No candidate shall be considered for admission after a lapse of more than 3 (three) years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination or discontinuation of recognized regular courses of study after passing the previous qualifying examination.

# The candidates qualifying the vocational courses can apply for 3-year B.A. (Bachelor's Degree) with Multidisciplinary Programme only.

#### [B] Courses Offered:

The college offers Semester Wise Undergraduate courses [4-year B.A. (Hons. / Hons. with Research) with Major and 3-year B.A. (Bachelor's Degree) with Multidisciplinary Programme], a list of which along with the subject combinations is given above.

For each B.A. (Hons. / Hons. with Research) with Major course, two Minor Subjects (I & II) must have to be taken as subject combination.

For B.A. (Bachelor's Degree) with Multidisciplinary Programme, two subjects must have to be taken as Major Disciplines (A & B) and one subject must have to be taken as Minor Discipline (C) as subject combination.

All valid applicants appearing in the Merit lists for the Honours/General courses must bring the following documents at the time of verification:

- ALL DOCUMENTS (IN ORIGINAL AND SELF-ATTESTED TESTIMONIALS) LIKE H.S. MARKSHEETS ADMIT CARD FOR MADHYAMIK OR EQUIVALENT EXAMINATION, CASTE CERTIFICATE AND PH CERTIFICATE (IF APPLICABLE), ETC.
- TWO RECENT STAMP-SIZE COLOR PHOTOGRAPHS.

All applicants in the Merit List may take their admission to the respective courses directly on the date mentioned on college website.

# **Keep In Mind:**

As per the recent verdict of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, ragging and sexual harassment in any form are criminal offences. - 3. After getting admission, if a candidate wishes to discontinue his/her studies or wants to strike out his/her name from this college, money will be refunded on the basis of the order issued by the Higher Authority.
- 4. Ragging in all forms is liable to appropriate disciplinary action.
- 5. Eligibility to appear in V.U. Examinations is subject to attendance in college as per V.U. norms as follows:
- 6. A candidate attending less than 75% but not below 60% of attendance in one or more subjects/groups of subjects shall be declared as NON-COLLEGIATE and may be allowed to appear at the concerned examination on payment of requisite Non-Collegiate fees.
- 7. A candidate attending less than 60% lectures delivered and practical classes held in one or more subject(s)/group(s) of subjects shall be declared as DISCOLLEGIATE and shall be debarred from appearing at the V.U. Examination.
- 8. Attendance in a subject/group of subjects shall be counted from the date of commencement of classes or admission to the course whichever is later.

**N.B:** If any kind of error is found in the application form or the candidate is unable to produce the relevant documents (like Caste Certificate, Mark sheet etc.) during the time of Physical Verification, the admission of the candidate will be cancelled.
